HALF-MASTING OF FLAGS

EFFECTIVE: March 26, 2018

APPROVED BY COUNCIL: March 26, 2018



1. Purpose

To provide protocol related to the half-masting of flags at Township of Scugog municipal facilities.

2. Policy

- a. Flags are flown at the half-mast position as a sign of respect and condolence or to commemorate significant dates. The flags flown at Township properties shall only be flown at halfmast on the death of, up to and including the day of the funeral for the following:
 - Reigning Monarch or a member of the immediate Royal Family (spouse, son or daughter, father, mother, brother or sister of the Reigning Monarch).
 - Present or former Governor General
 - Present or former Prime Minister
 - The Lieutenant Governor
 - The Premier
 - Current Durham Member of Parliament and Member of Provincial Parliament
 - Current or former Mayor
 - Current Member of Council
 - Current Member of Staff
 - Member of the Mississaugas of Scugog Island First Nation community
 - Any other person whom it is desired to so honour, at the direction of the Mayor

3. Procedure

When a flag is flown at half-mast, all other flags must also be flown at half-mast, no flag should be lower than any other flag.
